Open Day to help residents to move on to permanent housing

North Herts Sanctuary (NHS) has announced it will be hosting an Open Day on Friday, December 16 for landlords in the Stevenage and North Hertfordshire area to secure housing for residents ready to move on to permanent accommodation. Nobel Solicitors will be available at the event to provide legal advice, and the North Herts District Council Housing Benefit team will be able to provide landlords with housing benefit advice. There will be a presentation on the North Herts Sanctuary Resettlement Programme which will discuss the life skills and housing support the Sanctuary provides that is essential for clients to be responsible and reliable tenants.

Landlords who have rooms, bedsits or one bedroom flats available in the area are invited attend the event, which will be held from between 11 am to 1 pm and then from 3.30-5.30 pm at 25 Nightingale Road, Hitchin. Refreshments will be served.

"There is a shortage of social housing in North Hertfordshire, and we are hoping this event will help us secure more living accommodation for our clients who, with our support, are ready to move on to permanent housing," says Gboyega Adetunji, Project Manager, North Herts Sanctuary.
